Subject: ICAO global advanced air mobility (AAM) competitions in advance of the AAM 2024 Symposium (Mantréel Canada O to 12 September 2024)

Action required: Disseminate the information related to a) ICAO Global AAM Academic Paper Competition to universities; and b) ICAO Global AAM Photo Competition to aviation communities

Sir/Madam.

- 1. I have the honour to inform you regarding two initiatives scheduled during the lead-up to the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) first Advanced Air Mobility Symposium (AAM 2024). The symposium is expected to convene from 9 to 12 September 2024, in Montréal, Canada, (EB 2023/12 refers) and will bring together representatives from governments, industries, academia, and international organizations to collectively shape the global development of AAM.
- 2. In view of ICAO's ongoing commitment to foster collaboration, innovation, and the future of air transportation, two outreach initiatives are being launched: the ICAO Global AAM Academic Paper Competition and the ICAO Global AAM Photo Competition.
- 3. The objectives of these competitions are to engage university students and aviation community members with the different concepts and technologies related to AAM, thereby nurturing a sense of enthusiasm and interest in this emerging field of aviation. More specifically, the competitions aim to:
 - a) foster enhanced exchanges with and gather inputs from academia to inform ICAO's current and future work on AAM;
 - b) foster societal acceptance of AAM and its role in supporting urban and inter-urban mobility; and
 - c) energize academia to engage actively in the development of AAM.
- 4. The AAM sector has the potential to redefine how air transportation is perceived and experienced. Therefore, these competitions will serve as a dynamic platform, drawing together diverse perspectives, cutting-edge research, and innovative ideas from individuals worldwide. Detailed information

- 5. I encourage you to distribute this letter to all appropriate entities within your academic and aviation communities in order to reach a global audience, foster participation, and facilitate an exchange of dynamic ideas.
